Did you know that...

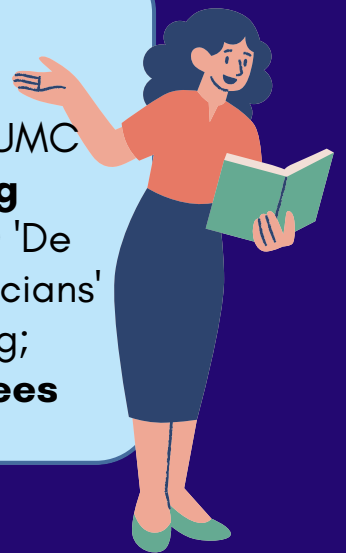
...our research focus included the topics of gendered medicine, physician well-being, learning & teaching climate, (self-)compassion and performance assessment?
