> ...we welcomed a fellow researcher and practicing GP from Brazil, Naarai Camboim, MD. She introduced and investigates the System for Evaluation of Teaching Qualities (SETQ) in Brazil. Her 8 months stay with PP&CC was enriching for all of us; and fun!

...in 2024, the Perito Professional Performance Platform assisted hospitals in completing **991 feedback reports**, in total **576** supervisors received a **SETQ report**.
